

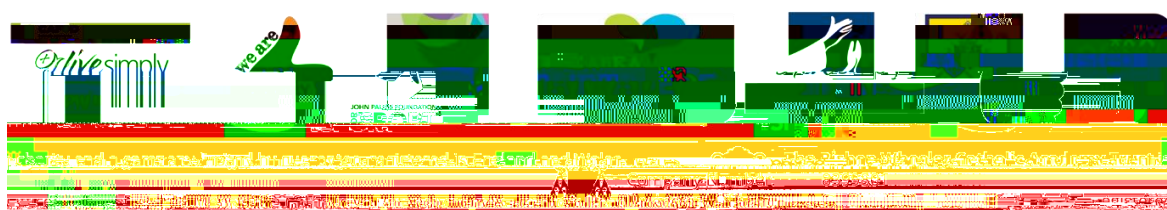

POLICY STATEMENT

462 of the Education Act 1996 which sets out the law on charging for school activities. The Academy Council focusses upon providing the best education possible at a time of increasing demands on funding. The aim of this policy is to set out charges, refunds, remissions, the circumstances under which voluntary contributions will be requested and the process for applying for financial support.

Charges

School Trips and Visits: Pupils are encouraged to take part in our varied calendar of school trips and visits. Some activities take place during the school day; others outside of school time. Visits may be a prescribed part of the curriculum, others are deemed to exceed the cost of the visit.

Cancellation by school: Where an activity has been cancelled due to insufficient voluntary contributions, all payments received will be refunded in full.
